

AUSTAR 2012 Toyota AFL Premiership Season / NRL Telstra Premiership Season Tipping Competition Terms and Conditions of Entry

1. Information on how to enter and prizes forms part of these Terms & Conditions of Entry. These Terms and Conditions of Entry serve as the Terms and Conditions of Entry for each of the in-venue Tipping Competitions being conducted by the Promoter.
2. Entries not complying with these Terms & Conditions of Entry are ineligible and the Promoter reserves its absolute right to disqualify any Participant or Group from the Tipping Competition if any entries do not comply with these Terms & Conditions of Entry.
3. In these Terms & Conditions of Entry, unless the contrary intention appears, the following words and phrases have the meanings set out below:
 - “Match” means a single game, between member teams in the 2012 Toyota AFL Premiership Season and/or 2012 NRL Telstra Premiership Season;
 - “Participant” means a person who is eligible to participate in the Tipping Competition;
 - “Participating Venues” means those venues who are current AUSTAR for Licensed Venues or AUSTAR Digital for Licensed Venues who are actively promoting and conducting the Tipping Competition in their venue.
 - “Results” are the results of Matches as officially determined during the 2012 Toyota AFL Premiership Season and/or 2012 NRL Telstra Premiership Season in accordance with the rules of that league following the completion of a Round;
 - “Round” means a round of the relevant 2012 Toyota AFL Premiership Season and/or 2012 NRL Telstra Premiership Season;
 - “Season” means the 2012 Toyota AFL Premiership Season and/or 2012 NRL Telstra Premiership Season;
 - “Score” means the allocation of points to a Participant for the correct selection of winning teams;
 - “Tipping Competition” means the “AUSTAR Tipping Competition” (where the context provides) of either the 2012 Toyota AFL Premiership Season or the 2012 NRL Telstra Premiership Season whereby winning entries are based on the Results of Matches at the conclusion of either round 24 of the 2012 Toyota AFL Premiership Season, or round 26 of the 2012 NRL Telstra Premiership Season. Where we mean both Tipping Competitions (i.e. for the major prize draw) this will be expressed clearly.
4. The Tipping Competition is open to Australian residents living in NSW, QLD, SA, ACT, NT, WA, VIC & Tas who are 18 years of age or over. Employees of the Promoter and its agencies associated with this Tipping Competition (including Participating Venues) and their immediate families are ineligible to enter. Participating Venues will be eligible to be awarded prizes only as otherwise set out in these Terms and Conditions.
5. Entry into the Tipping Competition is available from 9.00am ADST on 29/03/2012 and the competition closes at 6.59pm AEST on 05/09/2012.
6. To register to participate in the Tipping Competition, a Participant must register their details with a Participating Venue using the registration form provided by Participating Venue staff.
7. Once registered for the Tipping Competition, the Participant must select the team in each Match of the Round that they tip to win. A draw cannot be selected as a Match selection.

8. Participants will be allocated one point towards their Score for each correct selection of a winning team. In the event of a Match in a given Round being drawn, cancelled, abandoned, not completed or not played for any reason and/or a Result is not officially declared within three (3) days of the date the Match was originally scheduled to be played, it is treated as a win for both teams competing in that Match and the Participant will be awarded one point toward their Score for that Match.
9. The Scores at the end of round 24 for the 2012 Toyota AFL Premiership Season Tipping Competition, or 26 for the NRL Tipping Competition will be used to determine the winner of each Participating Venue's Tipping Competition. If at any time a Participant:
 - does not submit an entry for a given Match in a Round, then the Participant will receive a zero score for that Match; and
 - does not submit a tip for any one or more weekly games during the Season, the Participant's tips for that Round will receive a zero score.
10. Information about a Participant is used by the Promoter and their agencies associated with the Competition for the determination of winners and distribution of prizes awarded to a Participant. By entering the Tipping Competition, Participants consent to publishing their name and accumulated winning points in the results poster found in the Participating Venue. The Promoter will not be held responsible for any loss of reputation, status or otherwise in connection with a Participant's tipping selections and consequential results. Information about Participants may also be used by the Promoters, their agents, contractors and related companies, for the purposes of carrying out marketing, planning, product development and direct mail and promotional campaigns unless a Participant otherwise withdraws their consent to the use of their information in this manner.
11. In the event there is a dispute concerning the conduct of the Tipping Competition, the decision of the Promoter is final and no correspondence will be entered into.
12. Each Participant who achieves the highest score in the corresponding Participating Venue's Tipping Competition at the end of round 24 for the 2012 Toyota AFL Premiership Season Tipping Competition, and round 26 for the NRL Tipping Competition will be awarded one (1) entry in to the major draw to win the grand prize. In the case of a tied 'highest score' at a Participating Venue, all entrants with the highest score will be entered in the draw.
13. The Promoter will conduct 4 prize draws for the AUSTAR Tipping Competition at Ground Floor, 15 Grosvenor Street, Neutral Bay, NSW 2089 at 9.00am AEST on 12/09/2012. The judges' decision is final and binding and no correspondence will be entered into.
14. The Promoter accepts no responsibility for lost, late or misdirected entries throughout the Tipping Competition.
15. There will be one (1) major winner drawn from all winning entries from both Tipping Competitions (i.e. 2012 Toyota AFL Premiership Season and the 2012 NRL Telstra Premiership Season). There will be four (4) runner up winners and four (4) Participating Venue winners. The winners will be notified by phone, email & mail, & their names will be published in The Australian newspaper on 14/09/2012.
16. Draw 1 - The first valid entry drawn from all eligible entries received from both Tipping Competitions in NSW, ACT, QLD, SA, VIC, TAS & NT will win the Major Prize:
 - a <please insert model eg. Ascent Hatch/Conquest Hatch/Sedan; transmission eg. Automatic/manual; how many doors; colour etc> Toyota Corolla car.
 - Includes all on Road Statutory costs
17. The maximum retail value of the Draw 1 prize is \$20,000 (based on NSW Registration).
 - a. Ancillary Costs: All insurances, service charges, taxes, transfers and ancillary costs are not included in a Prize unless specified and are the responsibility of the Prize Winner.
 - b. Taxes: If a Prize or receipt of it incurs a tax liability, the Prize Winner is liable for payment of such tax.
 - c. Prize Availability: All components of the Prize, including the car and registration plates are subject to the colours and

models available, and certain colours and models may not be available. In the event that any component of a Prize is unavailable for any reason, subject to State legislation, the Promoter reserves the right to substitute that Prize component with another prize of equal value and the Prize Winner will be notified accordingly.

d. Date Prize to be Delivered: Delivery will be to the prize winners nearest Toyota Dealer where a thorough handover of the vehicle will be made.

18. Draw 2A - The first valid entry drawn from all eligible entries received from NSW, ACT, QLD, SA & NT entered in the Tipping Competition (AFL) will win:

- a trip for two (2) people to the 2012 Toyota AFL Grand Final including return economy airfares from the winner's nearest Australian capital city, to the city where the game will take place (for the winner and their guest)(Flight associated taxes are included), (if necessary), or other suitable transport as determined by the Promoter in its absolute discretion;
- 2 nights twinshare accommodation for the winner and his/her guest at a four star hotel of the Promoter's choice; and
- 2 general admission tickets to attend the 2012 Toyota AFL Grand Final.

In addition, the Promoter will award the same prize as set out in clause 18 above to the Participating Venue at which the winner participated in the Tipping Competition which may be used by the owner/manager or an employee from the Participating Venue plus one guest. The following terms and conditions relating to the awarding of the prize, will also apply to the Participating Venue winner. The Participating Venue prize will only be awarded to the Participating Venue once the prize is claimed or any second chance draw has been drawn.

19. Each prize in Draw 2A is valued at a maximum \$5,000. The maximum retail value of the Draw 2 prize pool (which is a total of 2 prizes) is \$10,000 (and will depend upon each winner's point of departure).

20. Draw 2B – the first two valid entries drawn from all eligible entries received in NSW, ACT, QLD, SA & NT entered in the Tipping Competition (2012 NRL Telstra Premiership Season) will win:

- a trip for two (2) people to the 2012 NRL Telstra Grand Final including return economy airfares from the winner's nearest Australian capital city, to the city where the game will take place (for the winner and their guest) (Flight associated taxes are included), (if necessary), or other suitable transport as determined by the Promoter in its absolute discretion;
- 2 nights twin share accommodation for the winner and his/her guest at a four star hotel of the Promoter's choice; and
- 2 general admission tickets to attend the 2012 NRL Telstra Grand Final.

21. In addition, the Promoter will award the same prize as set out in clause 20 above to each of the Participating Venues at which both of the winners participated in the Tipping Competition which may be used by the owner/manager or an employee from the Participating Venue plus one guest. The following terms and conditions relating to the awarding of the prize, will also apply to the Participating Venue winner. Maximum retail value of each prize is \$5 000. The Participating Venue prize will only be awarded to the Participating Venue once the prize is claimed or any second draw has been drawn.

22. Each prize in Draw 2B is valued at a maximum \$5,000. The maximum retail value of the Draw 2B prize pool (which is a total of 4 prizes) is \$20,000 (and will depend upon each winner's point of departure).

23. Draw 3 - The first valid entry drawn from all eligible entries received from Vic & Tas entered in the Tipping Competition (2012 Toyota AFL Premiership Season) will win:

- a trip for two (2) people to the 2012 Toyota AFL Grand Final including return economy airfares from the winner's nearest Australian capital city, to the city where the game will take place (for the winner and their guest)(Flight associated taxes are included), (if necessary), or other suitable transport as determined by the Promoter in its absolute discretion;
- 2 nights twinshare accommodation for the winner and his/her guest at a four star hotel of the Promoter's choice; and
- 2 general admission tickets to attend the 2012 Toyota AFL Grand Final.

24. In addition, the Promoter will award the same prize as set out in clause 23 above to the Participating Venue at which the winner participated in the Tipping Competition which may be used by the owner/manager or an employee from the Participating Venue plus one guest. The following terms and conditions relating to the awarding of the prize, will also apply to the Participating Venue winner.
25. Each prize in Draw 3 is valued at a maximum \$5,000. The maximum retail value of the Draw 3 prize pool (which is a total of 2 prizes) is \$10,000 (and will depend upon each winner's point of departure).
26. The maximum retail value of the total prizepool (which is a total of 9 prizes) is \$60,000.
27. For prizes in Draws 2A, 2B & 3 spending money, additional meals, room service, taxes, insurance, transport to and from departure point, transfers to and from arrival point and all other ancillary costs are the responsibility of the winner and their guests. Flights must be taken to coincide with the 2012 Toyota AFL Grand Final / 2012 NRL Telstra Grand Final (whichever is applicable) and are subject to booking and flight availability. Travel must be booked by 20/09/2012 for the 2012 Toyota AFL Grand Final Grand prize winner and by 23/09/2012 for the 2012 NRL Telstra Grand Final Grand prize winner. The provision of tickets to any match that is a declared event under the Major Sporting Events Act 2009 ("Act").
28. The Draw 2A, 2B and Draw 3 major prizes are a single event holiday and cannot be separated into different holiday vacations. All passengers must travel together on the same flights and stay at the same accommodation. If the winner resides in the city where their Grand Final prize takes place, they will forfeit the airfare portion of the prize and no compensation will be given in lieu.
29. The Promoter shall not be liable for any loss, damage or personal injury whatsoever which is suffered or sustained (including but not limited to indirect or consequential loss) as a result of taking a prize, except for any liability which cannot be excluded by law. The winners and their guest also acknowledge that participation in and attendance at any event (including travel and accommodation providers) may be subject to additional terms and conditions imposed by third parties. The Promoter does not accept any responsibility and is not liable for additional conditions imposed at any event or for the breach of those conditions by any person
30. The Promoter accepts no responsibility for any variation in the prize value. Prize is not transferable or exchangeable and is not redeemable for cash. In the event that the prize becomes unavailable for reasons beyond the Promoter's control, the Promoter may substitute a prize of equal or greater value subject to the approval from the Lottery Departments.
31. Where a prize remains unclaimed as at 9.00am AEST on 20/09/2012 for the Tipping Competition, the Promoter will conduct such further draws at that time and date, at the same place as the original draw as are necessary, in order to award a prize, to be determined by the Promoter in its absolute discretion but of equivalent value to the original prize. In the event of a new winner, the winner will be notified by phone, email & mail, & their names will be published in The Australian newspaper on 24/09/2012. The winner from the Participating Venue will only be advised after the date of any unclaimed prize draw.
32. Where a particular state or territory law requires a longer period of time (than provided in condition 26) for the winner to claim the prize before any redraw is conducted, the prize will be forfeited at 5.00pm on 14/12/12 if it remains unclaimed at that time. The Promoter will conduct a further draw at the same time and place as the original draw on 07/01/13 subject to any applicable law. In the case of an expired event the winner will forfeit the event portion of the prize and no compensation will be given or paid in lieu. The winner(s) (if applicable) will be notified by phone, email & mail, & their names will be published in The Australian newspaper on 14/01/13.
33. The Promoter reserves the right to request verification of age, identity and residential address of winners. Verification is at the discretion of the Promoter, whose decision is final.
